I am writing to inform you that on June 28, 2012, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation with Stipulations* to Temple City Unified School District and all of its credential programs.

Following is the stipulation:

- That the Temple City Unified School District provide evidence of the implementation of a formalized, systematic, and consistent professional development and training plan for all support providers.

On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to continue to offer the following approved program(s):

- General Education (Multiple/Single Subject) Induction

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- Temple City Unified School District is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- Temple City Unified School District continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
