I am writing to inform you that on March 14, 2012, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation* to Los Angeles Unified School District and all of its credential programs.

On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to recommend candidates for the following credentials:

- Preliminary Multiple Subject Intern (inactive)
- Preliminary Single Subject Intern
- Education Specialist Credential
 - Level I Program: Mild/Moderate Disabilities, Intern
 - Level I Program: Moderate/Severe Disabilities, Intern

 - Preliminary Education Specialist: Mild/Moderate Disabilities, with Intern
 - Preliminary Education Specialist: Moderate/Severe Disabilities, with Intern

 - Professional Level II
 - Mild/Moderate Disabilities
 - Moderate/Severe Disabilities
- Special Education Added Authorization: Autism Spectrum Disorders
- General Education (MS/SS) Induction

In addition:

- Los Angeles Unified School District is to provide in its next regularly scheduled biennial report, aggregated data that demonstrates that a unit assessment system is fully implemented. Information about this biennial report will be presented to the Committee on Accreditation.

- In its next regularly scheduled biennial report, the Los Angeles Unified School District is to provide aggregated candidate assessment and program effectiveness data for the candidates who are enrolled and who have completed the new Preliminary Education Specialist program.
- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- Los Angeles Unified School District is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- Los Angeles Unified School District continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
