I am writing to inform you that on June 23, 2011, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation* to Modesto City Schools and all of its credential programs.

On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to offer the following program:

General Education (Multiple and Single Subject) Induction

The Commission requests the following items be addressed a 7th Year Report, due in May of 2012:

- That the Modesto City Schools report on its plan to increase recruitment of diverse support providers.
- That Modesto City Schools address report on its efforts to formalize stakeholder participation in the program.

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- Modesto City Schools is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- Modesto City Schools continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
