- Point Loma Nazarene University is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- Point Loma Nazarene University continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
