Dear President Breen:

I am pleased to inform you that on June 26, 2015, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, took action to remove four stipulations placed on Pacific Union College, altered the remaining stipulations, changed the accreditation status of Pacific Union College from *Accreditation with Probationary Stipulations* to **Accreditation with Stipulations**.

Below are the remaining stipulations that must still be addressed within six months:

- Pacific Oaks College is to submit evidence demonstrating that it meets Education Specialist Program Standard 5: Assessment of Students. The institution is to follow with data related to this standard in the institution's next Biennial Report.
- Pacific Oaks College is to address Education Specialist for Mild/Moderate Program Standard 6: Case Management.
