Dear President Kassing:

I am writing to inform you that on April 22, 2011, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation with Stipulations* to San Jose State University and all of its credential programs.

Following are the stipulations to be met:

That within the next 12 months the institution provides evidence that all issues identified as not met in the Multiple Subjects Credential program be fully addressed. This includes the following:

- That each candidate for a Multiple Subject teaching credential has experience in a classroom where beginning reading is taught.
- That each Multiple Subject candidate receives supervised practice to help prepare each candidate to plan and deliver content specific instruction in mathematics, science, history-social science, visual and performing arts, physical education and health and that candidates demonstrate the basic ability to plan and implement instruction that supports student learning in each of these subject areas.
- That each Multiple Subject teaching candidate observes and participates in two or more of the following grade spans: K-2, 3-5, and 6-9.

On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to recommend candidates for the following Credentials:

- Multiple Subject  
Multiple Subject Credential with BCLAD
- Single Subject  
Single Subject Credential with Internship
- Education Specialist Credentials  
Preliminary  
Mild/Moderate Disabilities Internship  
Moderate/Severe Disabilities Internship  
Deaf and Hard of Hearing Credential (*inactive*)  
Early Childhood Special Education Certificate

Resource Specialist Certificate  
Added Authorization – Autism Spectrum Disorders

- Advanced/Services Credentials
  - Administrative Services
    - Preliminary
    - Professional (*inactive*)
  - Reading Language Arts Certificate
  - Reading Language Arts Specialist Credential
  - Pupil Personnel Services
    - School Counseling with Internship
    - School Social Work
    - Child Welfare and Attendance
  - Speech-Language Pathology Credential
  - Teacher Librarian Credential

In addition:

- San Jose State University is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- San Jose State University continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
- San Jose State University provide a 7<sup>th</sup> year report that addresses Common Standard 2 issues identified in the accreditation report.
