Dear Chancellor Wilcox:

I am writing to inform you that on June 13, 2016 the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of **Accreditation with Stipulations** to University of California, Riverside and all of its credential programs.

Following are the stipulations to be met:

- 1) University of California, Riverside is to provide evidence of unit leadership that systematically provides oversight of all Commission-approved programs.
- 2) University of California, Riverside is to provide evidence of an implemented unit assessment system that consistently collects, analyzes and utilizes data on candidate and program completer performance and unit operations for unit effectiveness.
- 3) University of California, Riverside is to provide evidence that during the bilingual program all candidates complete fieldwork and are guided and coached on their performance in bilingual instruction using formative assessment processes and verification of candidates' performance provided by both institutional and field based individuals with bilingual expertise and/or possessing bilingual authorization.

On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to recommend candidates for the following Credentials:

Multiple Subject Credential  
Multiple Subject Intern

Single Subject Credential  
Single Subject Intern

Clear General Education (Multiple/Single Subject) Induction Program

Preliminary Education Specialist: Mild/Moderate Disabilities  
Preliminary Education Specialist: Moderate/Severe Disabilities  
Education Specialist: Added Authorization: Early Childhood Special Education

Pupil Personnel Services, School Counseling  
Pupil Personnel Services: School Psychology

Designated Subjects: Career and Technical Education (CTE)  
Designated Subjects: Special Subjects

Bilingual Authorization: Spanish

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- University of California, Riverside is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- University of California, Riverside continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
