I am writing to inform you that on June 23, 2011, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation* to University of the Pacific and all of its credential programs.

- Pupil Personnel Services

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.

- University of the Pacific is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- University of the Pacific continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
- The Commission also requests that University of the Pacific address all standards less than fully met in their 7th year report, due no later than May of 2012.
