I am writing to inform you that on February 1, 2012, the Committee on Accreditation, on behalf of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing, assigned the status of *Accreditation* to the University of San Diego and all of its credential programs.

On the basis of this decision, the institution is authorized to recommend candidates for the following credentials:

- Multiple Subject Credential
- Single Subject Credential
- Education Specialist
 - Deaf and Hard of Hearing
 - Deaf and Hard of Hearing Internship
 - Mild/Moderate Disabilities
 - Mild/Moderate Disabilities Internship
- Pupil Personnel Services
 - School Counseling
- Preliminary Administrative Services Credential
 - Preliminary Administrative Services Internship

In addition:

- The institution's response to the preconditions is accepted.
- The University of San Diego is permitted to propose new credential programs for approval by the Committee on Accreditation.
- The University of San Diego continues in its assigned cohort on the schedule of accreditation activities, subject to the continuation of the present schedule of accreditation activities by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
